So much so that acclaimed British producer Ian Catt (Sainte Etienne, Trembling Blue Stars) enthusiastically volunteered to mix 3 songs. The rest of the album was mixed by hip Canadian producer Dave Hodge (Brand Van 3000, Wu-Tang Clan). The result is an unmistakable work of art... a pop music masterpiece. Make no mistake, Heart will be remembered because the songs are so beautiful, and to Stars beauty is what will save us.
